E-LEARNING TOOLS: NEW MODULE ON COMPLIANCE WITH THE US ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR VESSELS TRADING TO THE UNITED STATES

Your Managers are pleased to report the release of a new e-learning module, entitled **Vessel General** Permit, to assist Members in complying with the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Vessel General Permit (VGP) environmental discharge requirements for vessels trading to the United States.

The 2008 VGP concerns discharges which are incidental to the normal operation of vessels engaged in transportation. The VGP includes general effluent limits applicable to all discharges; general effluent limits applicable to 26 specific discharge streams; narrative water-quality based effluent limits; inspection, monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements; and additional requirements applicable to certain vessel types.

The current requirements of the 2008 VGP are valid through December 18, 2013.
