GUIDELINES FOR SUPERVISION AND MANAGEMENT OF AIR POLLUTANT EMISSIONS IN THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (PRC)

The Maritime Safety Agency in the PRC has recently issued *Guidelines for Supervision and Management of Air Pollutant Emissions* to standardize the implementation of the January 1, 2020 sulfur cap.

The Guidelines define inspection procedures in regard to fuel oil in use on ships, and provisions for alternative measures. Worthy of particular attention are the standards applying to potential violations of the requirements.
